Accessibility:	Access to site fairly easy, but less so for less mobile people. Distances: bus stop 250 yards; shop 500 yards; post office 750 yards; town centre 750 yards; GP 300 yards.
Lifestyle:	Scheme for, or of particular interest to: all welcome, but we do take people from local churches. Monthly social activities include some, organised by friends of Abbeyfield, housekeeper. Some meals available (two meals every day). New residents accepted from 60 years of age. Please contact us to discuss if you wish to bring a pet.
Tenure:	Rent (social landlord).
Manager's notes:	<p>At an Abbeyfield house, our residents have the privacy of their own accommodation, combined with the companionship of others and the security and support of the dedicated house staff. We welcome applications from all sections of the community. Our residents enjoy home-cooked meals together every day. The charges are fully inclusive of food, cooking, utility bills and council tax.</p> <p>Many residents are eligible for Housing Benefit and other financial support to help towards the monthly cost. Abbeyfield is affordable to all and our staff can help advise you about this.
